COVID-19

Pursuant to Florida Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (FLHSMV) Emergency Orders 041320 and 043020, the following extensions for driver licenses and identification cards are in effect:

- Driver licenses and identification cards with expiration dates on or after March 16, 2020 through April 15, 2020 are extended for 60 days (Emergency Order 041320)
- Driver licenses and identification cards with expiration dates on or after April 16, 2020 through April 30, 2020 are extended for 30 days (Emergency Order 041320)
- Driver licenses and identification cards with expiration dates on or after May 1, 2020 through May 31, 2020 are extended for 30 days (Emergency Order 043020)
- Commercial driver licenses and commercial driver instructional permits with expiration dates on or after March 16, 2020 are extended through June 30, 2020 (Emergency Order 041320)
- In conjunction with the waiver issued by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, the requirements under section 322.59, Florida Statutes, that a person who holds a commercial driver license have a medical examination and certification are waived through June 30, 2020, provided the commercial driver has proof of a valid medical certification that was issued for a period of 90 days or longer and that expired on or after March 1, 2020 (Emergency Order 041320)
- All delinquent renewal fees during the extension periods are waived for these driver licenses/permits

These orders shall expire, except to the extent specific dates are provided herein, on the expiration or rescission of Executive Order 20-52 issued by the Governor.
